





- · Cleft lip or palate
- · Epispadias or undescended testicle (cryptorchidism)
- Extra fingers (polydactyly)
- Limited range of motion
- Nail problems, including missing or deformed nails
- Short arms and legs, especially forearm and lower leg
- Short height (between 3 1/2 and 5 feet tall)
- Sparse, absent, or fine textured hair
- Tooth abnormalities:
 - Peg teeth
 - · Widely spaced teeth
 - Teeth present at birth (natal teeth)
 - · Delayed or missing teeth





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Diagnosis

Exams and Tests

Signs of this condition include:

- Growth hormone deficiency
- Heart defects, such as a hole in the heart (atrial septal defect)
 occur in about half of all cases

Tests include:

- · Chest x-ray
- Echocardiogram
- Genetic testing may be available for mutations in the EVC gene
- · Skeletal x-ray
- Ultrasound
- Urinalysis

Treatment

Treatment List for Ellis-van Creveld syndrome

The list of treatments mentioned in various sources for Ellis-van Creveld syndrome includes the following list. Always seek professional medical advice about any treatment or change in treatment* plans.

- Multidisciplinary management
- Supportive care
- Dietary counselling
- Dental care-oral hygiene instruction, plaque control
- · Prosthetic rehabilitation
- Orthopedic procedures correct polydactyly and other orthopedic malformations
- Cardiac surgery may be needed to correct cardiac anomalies
- · Thoracic expansion has been attempted in some patients
- Urologic surgery is required if epispadias, cryptorchidism, or both are present

Genetic counseling can aid couples in making informed decisions about pregnancies












