Economic inequality




Current Issues: Muscles

- synthetic gene that, when injected into the muscle cells of mice, prevents and even reverses natural muscle deterioration
 - H. Lee Sweeney, University of Pennsylvania
 - Muscular dystrophy, muscle loss with aging
- Genetically enhanced athletes
 - Ethical?
 - Some athletes have always had genetic advantages

- Where do you draw the line?




Current Issues: Sex Selection
